The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), **an AKC Canine Partners listing number**, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place [**indoors, outdoors, outdoors under cover**] on a [**ring surface**] surface. Ring size will be [**ring size(s)**]. (*Exact size(s) or 'minimum of' allowed*)

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **25.00** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH rosette and decorated MACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A dog toy valued at three to five dollars will be awarded to all dogs that place in their respective height and class.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The MADOC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. MADOC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the MADOC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund **\$7.00** per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

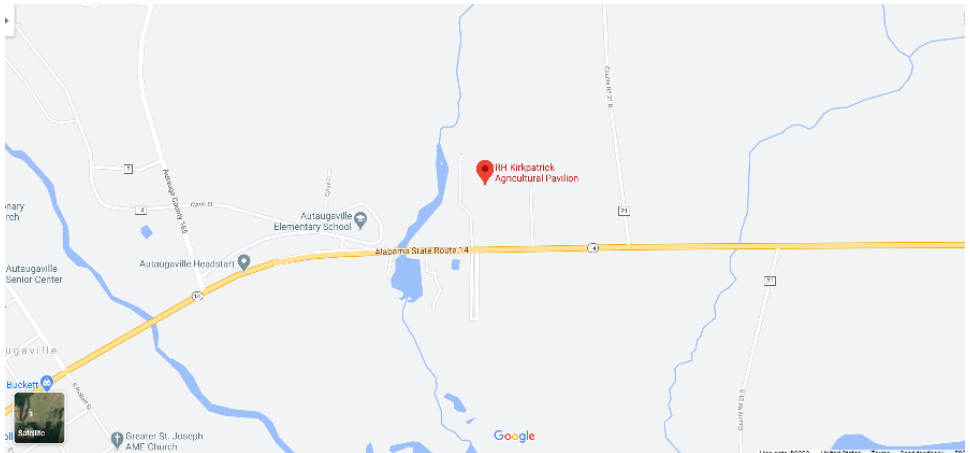

From East: Take I-85 to I-65, go north and follow instructions above.

From West (Selma, AL): Take AL-14 East approximately 25 miles.

COVID INFORMATION

COVID Guidelines for MADOC Agility Trials

Everyone's safety is our primary concern, especially during the current pandemic. We will comply with Alabama state and exhibition facility guidelines for reopening state and group events. Please keep in mind this is a very fluid situation, and state and local guidelines are subject to change with little notice. We reserve the right to adjust these guidelines as needed. We will try to keep everyone updated of any changes through emails from the trial secretary. We will be implementing the following guidelines:

1. Crating will be set up so that social distancing can be maintained between handlers at a minimum of 6 feet. You may choose to crate from your vehicle, also maintaining 6 feet distance.
2. Walk through groups will be split to facilitate better social distancing. Groups will be determined by the judge and trial chair based on entry numbers in each class.
3. Anyone entering the building will wear a mask, which will include all workers and ring crew. Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own mask. The mask should be solid with no vent and worn covering the nose and mouth. Exhibitors may remove their mask when entering the ring for their run and place it in their pocket, but you must put the mask on prior to exiting the ring.
4. Exhibitors will maintain six-foot social distancing inside and outside the building. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors.
5. There will be no seating/viewing near the ring or at the rail. Seating will be in your crating area, maintaining 6 feet apart. There will be a designated area marked for videoing runs.
6. Handlers may place their leash in their pocket or wear them while running the course. If your dog grabs the leash while on your person, the judge will rule this an "E." If handlers elect to drop their leash at the start, a leash runner will be provided to pick up and transport the leash.
7. Results will be posted on the wall of the facility. Tape will mark the area so that if you wish to view results, you can maintain social distance. Results will be emailed after the trial as well.
8. Course maps will be posted on the wall. Plan to take a picture of the maps. Trial course maps will be emailed to exhibitors the morning of or the day prior to the trial. There will be paper course maps.
9. There will be no open/buffet style hospitality. Competitors will need to bring their own food and drinks (non-alcoholic). Stay alert to updates on concessions available at this trial.
10. Please do not bring MACH cakes, desserts, or other treats to share with exhibitors.
11. Ribbons will be self-serve while maintaining a safe 6 feet distance. Use hand sanitizer before and after getting your ribbons.
12. There will be plenty of soap, paper towels and hand sanitizer. Please wash your hands frequently. We will have hand sanitizer and disinfecting supplies. We appreciate competitors bringing their own for personal use, also.
13. If you are ill, **DO NOT COME!** If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days, do not come! Covid-19 continues to change our daily lives. If you are entering this trial, be sure you are comfortable with the above guidelines and are willing to comply with social distancing and wearing a mask (these are non-negotiable). Exhibitors not complying with these guidelines will be excused from the trial without a refund.
14. Check your final confirmation for updates or changes to these guidelines.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
